Sola Community Peace Center Internship for Communications and Media

This internship is a program of Sola Community Peace Center for 25 hrs/wk for a college student for 2 months during summer – preferably June and July but could be adjusted according to intern's availability. It engages qualified young adults in creating organizational communications (newsletters, website, social media, print) for peace with justice programs with economically disadvantaged young people in the communities around USC. The intern will work with the Executive Director to curate messaging, content and photos for Peace Camp and other Sola Community Peace Center programs. The intern will distribute communications via online, social media and written channels and update the website. The intern must be able to take initiative and work independently.

Duties

- * Meet once a week with peace center director or designated staff
- * Work with Executive Director and Peace Camp staff to create a communications plan for Sola Community Peace Center
- * Create a plan for messaging through online channels, printed media, website, and social media
- * Implement communications plan through all the media channels
- * Develop and host at least one experiential Communications and Media skill-building workshop for Peace Camp youth interns and summer staff
- * Give feedback and suggestions for improvement in creating a media/communications plan going forward

Required Qualifications:

- * 18 years of age or older and graduation from high school or equivalent
- * Interest and experience with communications/media/social media
- * Interest in youth and peace with justice
- * Commitment to nonviolence
- * Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- * Excellent organizational and interpersonal skills
- * Ability to pass background check
